The Staff - Treble Clef

At the beginning of each staff there is a clef. The treble clef looks like an 'S' and is called the 'soprano' clef.

To draw the treble clef, draw the line and dot, then the top loop, the left loop, the right loop, and the dot.

The treble clef gives a position of 'middle C' on the staff (C is the first line of the treble staff).

Here are several other first and letters of the alphabet (A through Z).

1. To draw the treble clef, copy to writing over the dotted lines. Then draw the name of your name.

2. Draw a treble clef at the beginning of the staff. Then write the letter names of each note.

3. Draw a treble clef at the beginning of the staff. Then draw the notes indicated. If a note can't be written on a line then use a space on the staff, check out.
